PERSONAL STATEMENT OF POTTI ANIL

From the very start of my undergraduate study, I realised that my interests and potential lie in clinically oriented active management of patients. Infact the universal encouragement I received through out my Pre-medical School years was that I would be a good Physician because I enjoy, and am good at working with people. My desire to pursue graduate studies in field of Medicine will bring to fruition my ambition and sole aim of seeking a career in the field of Internal Medicine, and to specialize in cardiology.

ACADEMIC CAREER :

Though none of the members of my family have been through the medical profession, I had the opportunity of repeatedly visiting, *The Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad*; since my ~~grand father was a patient~~, suffering from Calcific Aortic Stenosis. During that period I was drawn by the flair and more importantly the dedication and courteousness of the consultant cardiologist Dr. Rajagopala Raju. It was at that time that I decided to join the Medical Profession.

It was because of my interest in the field of Medicine, and my ambition to specialize in Cardiology that I put in extra effort to be selected for my under graduate studies in "Christian Medical College, Vellore". Apart from being one among the only seven candidates chosen on pure merit through an examination held nation wide, i was also the only student selected from my state. **CHRISTIAN MEDICAL COLLEGE - VELLORE** requires special mention since it was then the leading institute for Cardiology & Cardiac Surgery with renowned physicians like Dr. Kutumbiah and Dr. I.P. Sukumar. To pursue my goal, I was awarded the prestigious **NTSE Scholarship** for my undergraduate study (*equivalent to the undergraduate NSF Fellowship*), after I stood fifth in the "National Talent Search Examination" held on a nationwide basis by the NCERT, New Delhi.

My undergraduate course has been rigorous and exacting, thus it has provided me with a thorough grasp of the fundamentals. Due to my fascination towards "THE HEART", I never missed out on seminars, paper-readings or clinical meetings involving the Departments of Cardiology & Cardiothoracic Surgery. I was even chosen to present a paper on "**PATHOLOGICAL BASIS OF CARDIAC VALVULAR LESIONS**" at an undergraduate conference held in ST. JOHNS MEDICAL COLLEGE - BANGALORE in 1991. I have always been ranked very high in my class with certificates of honour for proficiency and excellence in almost all the subjects.

CLINICAL EXPERIENCE :

I had never seen a rural hospital till I enrolled into the M.B.B.S. Course. I must also admit that I never did like the idea of working in a rural hospital. But somehow, I chose to work for a period of 15 days during my holidays at WORiyur hospital - TRICHY a branch of the Church of South India Hospitals. Though it was for a very short span of time, I would like to mention that I was touched by the philanthropic outlook maintained and the dedication of the physician towards healing the poor; though the facilities available to them were meagre. This was the first time I realised that neither fame nor fortune were necessary for a person to be regarded as a "great" physician in the community.

As per our schedule I have completed a one year program of rotating internship in CMCH - Vellore. Throughout the course, one basic tenet of medicine that was stressed on repeatedly, and which I sincerely hope I will carry with me throughout my career was "A patient is the most important person in a physicians life and it is this aspect - **commitment to patient care** which must take precedence - irrespective of the number of hours already worked in a day, the number of days worked in a week, or on-call schedules; without depriving the patient his basic right to expect an alert, responsible, and responsive physician dedicated to delivering effective and appropriate care".

PURPOSE OF GRADUATE STUDY :

My objective for graduate study and further specialization are underscored by my aspiration to become involved in University teaching and active patient management, neither of which would be completely satisfactory in the absence of the other. Though this would be exacting and strenuous. It is my belief that teaching fine tunes the ability to communicate with students and patients, apart from consolidating fundamentals. Provoked to some critical self evaluation, I have often realised that the one fault I could see was that I do not easily project confidence or authority in totally new roles. I have always needed experience and certainly in my knowledge base to present an appropriate authoritative image which is what patients always look for in the attending physician or surgeon.

It is my belief that graduate study will provide me with an opportunity to enhance my knowledge, to gain the necessary exposure and experience, to adapt to changes and to develop the vision and insight needed to implement creative options in a dynamic world and to stay at the forefront of my field of interest.
